CONFIRMATION PREPARATION PROCESS FOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

Confirmation is one of the Sacraments of Initiation, along with Baptism and Eucharist, all of which complete your membership in the Church. Confirmation is a celebration of the conscious awareness of the Holy Spirit in your life and choosing to make a commitment to work with that Spirit as a Roman Catholic. Confirmation, along with other Sacraments, are gifts of God's grace freely given. To be confirmed is a choice you will make over the course of the next year before the actual celebration of Confirmation in September 2014 and should be discussed with your parents and sponsor. The Confirmation Preparation Process will assist you in making a good decision about whether to be confirmed or not at this point in your life.

From the Catechism of the Catholic Church 1309:

Preparation for Confirmation should aim at leading the Christian toward a more intimate union with Christ and a more lively familiarity with the Holy Spirit—his actions, his gifts, and his biddings—in order to be more capable of assuming the apostolic responsibilities of Christian life. To this end catechesis for Confirmation should strive to awaken a sense of belonging to the Church of Jesus Christ, the universal Church as well as the parish community. The latter bears special responsibility for the preparation of confirmands.

Through weekly Mass attendance, daily prayer, participation in prayer experiences during the process and completion of the candidate sponsor workbook the candidate will move to a more intimate union with Christ and familiarity with the Holy Spirit. The catechesis for Confirmation presented at Confirmation group sessions and participation in youth events at the parish will awaken the sense of belonging to the Church universal as well as the parish community.

The preparation for Confirmation will include an entrance and exit interview, attendance at the information meeting/retreat with a parent and sponsor, four Confirmation Group Sessions, completion of six hours of service and active participation in youth activities at the parish. Information regarding scheduling interviews may be found on the back of this page. Group sessions will be offered several times throughout the year. An explanation of this new format and service suggestions will be explained at the information meeting which will take place before the retreat. Parents need not stay for the retreat portion, but are welcome. Youth activities may be found on the parish website, bulletin and outside room three in the lower church hall.
