## Medicare-Approved Drug Discount Card Information

Medicare's new prescription drug assistance began in May, 2004 when people with Medicare could sign up for a discount card to help them with some drug costs. This is a temporary program that ends December 31, 2005, when the permanent Medicare drug benefit goes into effect. It is available to all Medicare beneficiaries except those who get drug coverage from a state Medicaid or medical assistance program. There is no penalty if you do not sign up for a Medicare discount card. The cost for the card will be no more than \$30 each year. For certain people with limited incomes there will be no charge for the card.
