

FIRST RECONCILIATION/FIRST COMMUNION INFORMATION SHEET 2013-14

Below is information for families with children entering second grade this fall. As part of the preparation for the reception of the sacraments of Reconciliation and Holy Eucharist, this year's program combines both classroom preparation for children and meeting times for parents. Please mark your calendar now with these important dates.

Preparation for the sacrament of **Reconciliation**:

- Parents' Retreat: Saturday, October 19, 9:30-11:30 in the FSPC (school cafeteria) OR Sunday, October 20, 10:45-12:45 in the FSPC (Parents only must attend one) no registration required attend either one Babysitting available contact Diane Hurtuk with ages of children and date you are attending.
- Reconciliation Retreat: Saturday, November 16 in the FSPC (Children only attend one) 9:00-11:00 or 12:00-2:00 (choose one-limit 50 Registration forms will be sent home. children per session)
- The sacrament of Reconciliation: Thursday, December 5, 7:00 p.m. OR (Families attend together) Saturday, December 7, 10:00 a.m.

Preparation for the Sacrament of First Eucharist:

- Parents' Retreat: Saturday, January 11, 9:30-11:30 in the FSPC OR
 Sunday, January 12, 10:45-12:45 in the FSPC

 (Parents only must attend one) no registration required attend either one
 Babysitting available contact Diane Hurtuk with ages of children and date you are attending.
- Child and Parent Luncheon/Retreat: Sunday, March 16, 12:15-2:00 FSPC (Second grader and one or both parents no babysitting offered) Registration forms will be sent home.
- **Jesus Day Retreat:** Saturday, April 5 in the FSPC (Children only attend one) 9:00-11:00 **or** 12:00-2:00 (choose one-limit 50 Registration forms will be sent home. children per session)
- **Group First Communion:** Saturday, May 3, 10:00 a.m. **Rehearsal:** Tuesday, April 29, 5:00-6:30 p.m.
- **Individual First Communions:** At any mass on the following dates: April 26-27, May 3-4, 17-18

Details about each sacrament will be discussed and home study books will be distributed at the Parent Retreats. Please plan to attend.
